

Three Currant Buns

*A Foodie Pattern
from
Displaced Moose!*

Crocheted Fun!



Pattern:

This pattern is worked in continuous rounds without joining.

Stitches Used

US Terminology

sc: single crochet

BLO: single crochet in the back loop only

decrease: insert hook in stitch and pull up a loop. *2 loops on hook.* Insert hook into next stitch and pull up another loop. *3 loops on hook.* YO and pull through all three loops on hook.

Materials

About 50 g of medium brown DK/heavy sport weight yarn.

Scraps of dark brown and red DK/heavy sport weight yarn

Toy stuffing

3.25 (D) hook

Tapestry needle

Currant Bun:

Round 1: With Medium Brown, 6sc in magic ring **OR** ch 2 and 6 sc in second ch from hook. (6sc)

Round 2: 2 sc in each sc (12sc)

Round 3: (sc, 2sc in next stitch), repeat 6 times (18sc)

Round 4: (2 sc, 2sc in next stitch), repeat 6 times (24sc)

Round 5: (3 sc, 2sc in next stitch), repeat 6 times (30sc)

Round 6: (4 sc, 2sc in next stitch), repeat 6 times (36sc)

Round 7: (5 sc, 2sc in next stitch), repeat 6 times (42sc)

Round 8: (6 sc, 2sc in next stitch), repeat 6 times (48sc)

Round 9: (7 sc, 2sc in next stitch), repeat 6 times (54sc)

Round 10: (8 sc, 2sc in next stitch), repeat 6 times (60sc)

Round 11-15: sc in each sc (60sc)

Round 16: sc in BLO in each stitch around (60sc)

Round 17: Through both loops, (8sc, decrease), repeat 6 times (54sc)

Round 18: (7sc, decrease), repeat 6 times (48sc)

Round 19: (6sc, decrease), repeat 6 times (42sc)

Round 20: (5sc, decrease), repeat 6 times (36sc)

Round 21: (4sc, decrease), repeat 6 times (30sc)

Round 22: (3sc, decrease), repeat 6 times (24sc)

Round 23: (2sc, decrease), repeat 6 times (18sc)

Round 24: (sc, decrease), repeat 6 times (12sc).

Stuff bun firmly.

Round 25: Decrease around (6sc)

FO, leaving a long tail to sew opening closed. Weave in ends.

With Dark Brown and a tapestry needle, embroider 'currants' over sc stitches in a random pattern.

Cherry:

Round 1: With Red, 6sc in magic ring **OR** ch 2 and 6 sc in second ch from hook. (6sc)

Round 2: 2 sc in each sc (12sc)

Round 3: (sc, 2sc in next stitch), repeat 6 times (18sc)

Round 4-5: sc in each stitch around (18sc)

Round 6: (sc, decrease), repeat 6 times (12sc)

Stuff cherry firmly.

Round 7: Decrease around (6sc)

FO and leave long tail to sew cherry to top of bun. It works best if the bottom of the cherry is not sewn shut, as this gives you a flat area to sew to the top of the curved bun.

Make as many as you like!

Dimensions: The finished buns are about 4 inches/10 cm in diameter made with DK weight yarn and a 3.25 mm hook. Depending on how firmly they are stuffed, they stand about 3 inches/8 cm high.



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
